Change of clothes: Students are welcome to bring a change of clothes to wear at ASP.

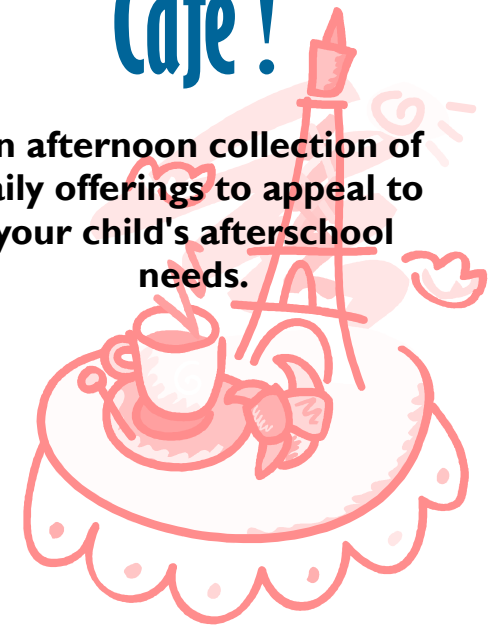
Sign in/Sign out: There is a sign in & out sheet that we use. Everyday your child will sign in, and when you pick him or her up you will need to sign your child out.
