

Saint Project – Due Nov. 11

1. Choose a quote
2. Copy it down, and who said it
3. Work on the Drawing and the Reflection

Drawing

*Look at the example

*Make the quotation the MAIN focus of the drawing. Adding additional color and decorations are important, but they should NOT dominate the picture.

Grading for the drawing will be:

- 5 points for having the quote and the author written **neatly**, in the center of the drawing, as the MAIN focus of the drawing
- 5 points for the additional color and decoration on the drawing

Reflection

You will need to share the quotation with at least 1 adult, and talk with them about what it means. You will use ideas from this conversation in your reflection. You may write or type your reflection.

- 1 point - write the quotation and saint who said it
- 1 point - write the name of the adult you shared this quote with and their relationship to you
- 3 points- use ideas from the conversation you had with an adult
- 4 points - **reflect** - write what you think the saint is saying- what does it mean?
- 4 points - **connect** the quote to your life
- 2 points - length should be $\frac{3}{4}$ page

Grading for the reflection will be:

15 points for a reflection which satisfies all of the objectives
